



## **ICC YAF event in San Salvador on Mechanisms for Challenging Arbitral Awards**

13 December 2012

The II Central American Convention of Centers of Arbitration took place on 22-23 November 2012. The Latin American Chapter of ICC YAF was glad to support this event as it did last year. Representatives from the major arbitration institutions of the region were present, as well as practitioners and academics. Panels' focus was centered on the current situation of arbitration in the region, especially on the centers' roles in its promotion and consolidation in Central America.
