- Conceptualize and execute a variety of web, electronic, and print projects as directed
- Provide designs for branding/identity, ads (web & print), brochures, and various other print materials
- Create brand identity style guidelines , (specifically colors, typefaces, and graphic styles)
- Ability to handle multiple tasks, meet deadlines, and turn projects around quickly
- Must be able to produce comprehensive instruction sheets for products produced.
- Photography, video and web design knowledge is a plus.
