

How to get into Paris:

Arriving at the airport Charles de Gaulle:

By Train

Regional train : RER B



The RER B links Paris-Charles de Gaulle to Paris and its Suburbs.

The station « Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 1 » serves terminals 1 and 3.

The station « Aéroport Charles de Gaulle 2 - TGV » serves terminals 2 ABCDEF and G.

Terminal 2G is linked to terminal 2C (entrance 4) by the free N3 shuttle (average journey time : 15 minutes).

Journey time* : 50 min to Paris-Châtelet les Halles

Fare : €8.40 (Pass Navigo zone 1-5 accepted) for a journey Paris-Châtelet les Halles > Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport.

Roissybus

The Roissybus shuttle provides a link between the centre of **Paris (Opéra station)** and Paris-Charles de Gaulle.

Stops for Roissybus at Paris-Charles de Gaulle :

Terminals 2A, 2C, 2E-2F, 2D, 2B, 3 and 1.

Terminal 2G is linked to terminal 2C (entrance 4) by the free N3 shuttle (average journey time : 15 minutes).

Journey time : 45 to 60 minutes

Fare* : €9.10 (Pass Navigo zones 1-5 accepted)

351 bus

The 351 bus provides a link between **Paris (Nation)** and Paris-Charles de Gaulle.

Stops for 351 bus at Paris-Charles de Gaulle :

Terminals 2A, 2C, 2E-2F, 2D, 2B and 1.

Terminal 2G is linked to terminal 2C (entrance 4) by the free N3 shuttle (average journey time : 15 minutes).

Journey time : 45 to 60 minutes

Noctilien Night bus

Paris-Charles de Gaulle is linked to the Corbeil-Essonnes railway station by the Noctilien night bus line 120, to the La Verrière railway station by line 121, and to the Paris-Gare de l'Est railway station by line 140.

Noctilien bus stops at Paris-Charles de Gaulle :

Terminals 1, 2F and 3

Terminals ABCDE are linked to terminal 2F, either by the pedestrian walkway (average journey time : 8 minutes) or the free N1 shuttle (runs from 4:30 to 1:30; average journey time : 8 minutes).

Terminal 2G is linked to terminal 2F ("galerie 6") by the free N2 shuttle (runs from 5:30 to 23:00; average journey time: 8 minutes).

Journey time: 60 min

Fare* : €6.40 (Pass Navigo zones 1-5 accepted).

Arriving at the airport Orly :

By Train

RER B

Paris-Orly is linked to the RER B station « Antony » by the ORLYVAL shuttle train.

Information: From Paris towards « Antony » take the trains heading for "Saint Remy les Chevreuses", from « Antony » towards Paris and its suburbs take the trains heading for "Mitry-Claye" or for "Aéroport Charles de Gaulle".

ORLYVAL shuttle train stops at Paris-Orly :

Paris-Orly South: entrance K

Paris-Orly West: entrance A Arrival level

Journey time: 25 min (RER) + 8 min (ORLYVAL)

Fare : €6.10 (RER) + €7.40 (ORLYVAL) (Pass Navigo zones 1-4 accepted for Paris-Antony, special fare for ORLYVAL)

RER C

Paris-Orly is linked to the RER C station «Pont de Rungis» by the bus service «Paris par le train».

From Paris towards «Pont de Rungis» take the trains heading for Massy – Palaiseau or "Pont de Rungis", from «Pont de Rungis» towards Paris or its suburbs, take the train heading for "Pontoise", "Versailles" or "Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines".

Stops for the busservice “Paris par le train”:

Paris-Orly South: entrance F

Paris-Orly West: entrance G Arrival level

Journey time : 25 min (RER) + 10 min (bus)

Fare : €3.60 (RER) + €2.50 (Bus) (Pass Navigo zones 1-4 accepted)

Orlybus

The Orlybus shuttle provides a link between Paris (Denfert-Rochereau station) and Paris-Orly.

Stops for Orlybus at Paris-Orly :

Paris-Orly South : entrance H

Paris-Orly West : entrance D Arrival level

Journey time: 20 to 30 min

Fare : €6.30 (Pass Navigo zones 1-4 accepted)

Cars Air France line 1

Cars Air France line 1 provide a link between Gare Montparnasse and Paris-Orly.

Stops for Les Cars Air France at Paris-Orly :

Paris-Orly South : entrance L

Paris-Orly West : entrance D Arrival level

Journey time : approx. 35 min

Fare : €11.50 (Pass Navigo not accepted).
