Marcus Wallenberg

Honorary Chairman of the International Chamber of Commerce



Marcus Wallenberg is the Chairman of Skandinaviska Enskilda Banken (SEB), Saab, and Electrolux AB. He is also the Vice-Chairman of L M Ericsson and serves on the boards of AstraZeneca, Thisbe AB, Stora Enso Oyj, Temasek Holdings, and the Knut and Alice Wallenberg Foundation.

Mr Wallenberg became Honorary Chairman of ICC in July 2008, after having served as Chairman since March 2006 and as Vice-Chairman since 2004.

From 1999 to 2005, Mr Wallenberg was President and CEO of Investor, after having served as Executive Vice-President of the company for six years. Prior to this he was Director of Stora Feldmühle in Düsseldorf.

Mr Wallenberg earned a B. Sc of Foreign Service from Georgetown University in Washington, D.C. and began his career at Citibank in New York. He then spent a decade gaining international banking experience working for Deutsche Bank in Frankfurt and Hamburg; S.G. Warburg in London; Citicorp in Hong Kong; and SEB in Stockholm and London. Mr Wallenberg speaks four languages: Swedish, English, French and German.

The Wallenberg family has helped lead ICC in many important ways over the years. Marcus Wallenberg's grandfather, Marcus, and uncle, Peter, each served as ICC Chairman from 1965 to 1967 and from 1989 to 1990, respectively. Peter Wallenberg continues as the only permanent Honorary Chairman of ICC.
